MINUTES - REGULAR MEETING

January 17, 2012

I. OPENING

- A. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m.
- B. Board President's Announcement:

The New Jersey Open Public Meetings Law was enacted to insure the right of the public to have advance notice of and to attend the meetings of public bodies at which any business affecting their interests is discussed or acted upon.

- C. President Holzberg led the flag salute.
- D. Roll Call: Galtieri, Geisenheimer, Geller, Majeski, Molina, Woods and Holzberg were all present.
- E. It was moved by Majeski, seconded by Galtieri and approved by unanimous voice vote to accept the minutes of the COW/Regular Meeting from December 19, 2011.
